



Greetings Lower Elementary Parents!

I hope that everyone is having a great summer. Back-to-school shopping is in full swing and I would like to touch base with you concerning a few things that the students will need to begin the **2017-18** school year.

Here is the list:

- (2) black and white composition books
- (2) 1 ½" 3 ring binder (solid color of your choice)
- (1) Large tri-fold display board 36" x 48" (BLACK)
- (1) Box of Crayola colored pencils
- (3) Double pocket folders
- Earbuds or small ear phones
- Boots for rain/snow
- Poncho or rain slicker
- (1) Backpack (approx. 11" x 17") solid color of your choice (Students may use last year's school bag if they prefer.)
- "Indoor shoes" to keep at school (see below)



The students will use the composition books for recording classwork and other materials will be used for art, math, language and geometry. We will use the "community system" for pencils and art materials, so it is not necessary to put your child's name on them or to purchase a pencil case. The students will also need to bring in plain soft slippers to wear inside the classroom. This helps to keep the classroom clean and the noise level down. The slippers should be plain (no characters or fancy designs please) with a non-skid sole and slip-on design. Moccasins are the best; please avoid mule or slippers that tend to fall off. Students should also bring an extra set of clothes to be kept at school in case of accidents.
